TOOTH COLORED FILLINGS

You have just had a tooth colored restoration placed. These are state of the art fillings that are made of a composite-resin material that are chemically bonded to your tooth structure.

Some of the symptoms you may experience afterwards are:

- Soreness at the site that the injection was given
- Sensitivity to cold
- Sensitivity while biting or chewing

These symptoms should disappear after a few days. If your filling is still noticeable after a week... **PLEASE CONTACT OUR OFFICE**. Sometimes a minor adjustment is all you will need.

Advil (Ibuprofen) is the best medication to take after dental procedures. Take Tylenol if you cannot take Advil.

Anytime a procedure is done to a tooth, there is always a chance that there could be an underlying problem, such as crack in the tooth or root, or even a diseased pulp (nerve). So please do not assume that "the pain will go away" – pain is a way of our bodies telling us that something may be wrong.
